Are you a passionate systems thinker who wants to explore how organizations can improve their impact through data analytics and refined internal management structures? Are you curious about food systems and supporting the future of our America's farms? American Farmland Trust has a unique opportunity for a remote (work from home) paid internship that will support deployment of internal project management systems as a means of increasing connectivity between our projects and departments.

In this paid internship, you will gather and clean data, then enter data into MS Dynamics as part of our overall project management methodology. You will also help create dashboards within the MS Dynamics framework to help our program staff understand their impact, project goals, and overall project statuses. Once you are comfortable within the Dynamics environment, you will also help produce short training videos that will help AFT adopt and fully utilize the Dynamics platform. Along the way, you will help us uncover new ways to utilize Dynamics and help implement best practices in project management methodology. You will work directly with AFT's project management staff, gaining valuable, relevant skills within a highly supportive environment that can be applied in both nonprofit and for-profit environments.

What You'll be Working On

- This position supports project management and data analysis across all AFT
 programs to help projects reach their goals on time and on budget. Responsibilities
 include, but are not limited to:
- Import project-specific data into Dynamics to create a more robust project management and reporting platform.
- Use the Dynamics dashboard feature to create graphs that help staff understand overall project status.
- Learn how to create new views within MS Dynamics and develop new views that reflect staff requirements.
- Create short (less than 5 minute) recorded instructional videos that staff can use to deepen their knowledge of the Dynamics system.
- Contribute to analysis of existing features within our project management system and provide insight on how these systems can be modified to increase use and overall performance.

Requirements

- College student or recent graduate.
- Strong written and oral communications skills.
- Organized, self-motivated, and able to work collaboratively within a remote environment.
- Interest in AFTs mission and passion for conservation agriculture.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Office.
- Willing to learn MS Dynamics and SharePoint.
- Flexible start date and flexible scheduling between 10 and 20 hours per week. This is a remote internship that will utilize the MS Teams platform for communication.
